



Investment Registering Requirements: For Joint Venture [JV]

Under the Investment Act 99/2021, the Government requires every Investor to obtain an investment license and submit the registration form and the required Documents to the Investment registration department. The following detailed will help you understand the key requirements and the overall registration process, to qualify for the investment certificate and investment incentives in Somaliland.

5.	National ID Card <i>(for Local Nationals)</i> / Passport Scan <i>(For foreign)</i>	
6.	Copy of Currant Visa / Resident Status <i>(For all foreign shareholders)</i>	
7.	Passport Size Photo 4.5cm x 3.5cm <i>(Owners / Chairman / Representative)</i>	
8.	Detailed Project proposal <i>(The Purpose, Scope, Objective, Anticipated Investment Capital, Revenue & expenditure for the first 3 years)</i>	
9.	Both Companies Profiles <i>(business Introduction, Vision & Management structure, Contacts)</i>	
10.	Notarized Shareholder Agreements <i>(Company owners/ Directors)</i>	
11.	Prove of Investment Capital over \$100,000 <i>(Bank Statement)</i>
